- Grief support costs an average of \$260 per person at no charge
- Includes: 13-months of bereavement services with phone calls and letters
- Day/evening support groups, workshops and individual counseling

\$1,000 helps send two children to special weekend grief camp

- Camp Jamie costs on average \$565 per child for ages 6–14 at no charge
- Combines one-on-one support with group activities
- Teaches coping skills and how to talk about their feelings
