

Cindy's husband, Steve, passed away under hospice care at the age of 42 from melanoma. Steve restored cars as a hobby, including a 1968 Mercury Cougar, a 1961 Cadillac De Ville and a 1956 Dodge C-Series truck.

Steve eventually sold the truck, something Cindy regretted after his death. She wanted to make sure each of her three sons had one of their father's vintage vehicles. So Trish suggested to Cindy that she could try to buy the truck back.

"One of the things we stress through our bereavement services is that although they may no longer be with us, the relationships we had with our loved ones doesn't end," Trish said. "Finding ways to continue to build bonds with them is important. For Cindy, that meant finding that truck and all it meant to Steve and her children."

Tracking down the truck proved to be a lesson in perseverance—and a true indication of Cindy's devotion to Steve.

Steve's emails did not provide any information on the buyer, nor did an internet search for '56 Dodge trucks. But Cindy's insurance agent was able to find the truck's vehicle identification number (VIN) on an old policy.

She then hired a private investigator to see if he could track the truck down. Several weeks went by before the investigator's wife called to say her husband had died of COVID. But she was able to glean enough information from his records to connect Cindy with the truck's owner. Cindy eventually reached him, told him her story, and he agreed to sell the truck back to her.

Cindy credits Trish with giving her "the push I needed" to undertake the search. Although Steve spent just a few days under hospice care before he died, Cindy is grateful for the care Hospice also provided to her. "I didn't realize that Hospice provides counseling but now I tell people to take advantage of it—even if you think you don't need it," she said. In addition to one-on-one counseling with Trish, Cindy also participated in Hospice's Spousal Support group.

"The group was the best thing for me," she admitted. "It made me feel like there are other people who know what I'm going through."

"Cindy deserves credit for being open to confronting her grief," Trish said. **"Grief is as individual as the person we lost, which is reflected in Cindy's desire to find Steve's truck. But there are also common threads to grief that when shared with others, can be very comforting. When it comes to grieving, don't be afraid to color outside the lines. Be creative and find whatever helps you heal."**

## A Note from Hospice Executive Director Carlos Graveran

Regular readers of this newsletter have become accustomed to messages from me in this space. We thought you might want to know more about some of our board members and why they have chosen to share their talents with Hospice.



## Board Member Spotlight: Charlie Smith

Charlie Smith's day job as Frederick County State's Attorney often involves helping victims of crime get justice for the loss of their loved ones. As such, he is no stranger to death.

It wasn't really until his own father, J. Charles Smith, Jr., a proud World War II Marine, entered hospice care that Charlie realized that he could use that experience and his commitment to community service to help others by serving as a member of the Frederick Health Hospice board of directors.

**"I'll admit that before our experience with Hospice, I had a lot of misconceptions about it," he said. "I wondered if it was right for Dad, if it was too soon for him to enter hospice, if it was too expensive, etc.** But when we talked to the Veterans Administration, they helped us overcome a lot of those misconceptions and told us that Dad was eligible for hospice care and that it would be covered."

In the ensuing weeks, Charlie began to truly appreciate what hospice offers the patient—and their loved ones. "The breadth of services provided by Hospice is just amazing. Aside from the medical care

they give, they offered my dad faith-based support, music therapy and they helped my mom. I found myself thinking, "What don't they provide?"

But it was Hospice's veterans services that touched the Smith family the most. "They came to the house and presented Dad with pictures and awards in honor of his service," Charlie recalled. "He was just beaming."

Charlie now wants to use his leadership skills and personal experience to help educate the community about hospice. "One of the first things I did when I joined the board was volunteer to chair the community outreach committee," he said. "Obviously, I did not truly understand what hospice offers prior to my experience, but it was a wonderful experience. I want to help spread the word to the community that they should investigate hospice sooner rather than later."

## Hospice Chaplain Helps Fulfill Wish

Elizabeth "Libby" Moser was determined to be baptized before she died.

Just days before she passed away, her brother called Hospice Chaplain Wes Parks to see if he would be available to baptize his sister in the pool of a Frederick area hotel. "He had everything arranged," Wes recalled. "So I met them at the hotel and talked with Libby for a bit. She told me, 'I'm going to heaven. I want to get baptized.'"

In the company of her husband, Merle, her daughter, Kelly, her sister and several of her extended family members, Libby walked into the pool where Wes performed the ceremony.

**When it was over, Libby went home with her family. She died a few days later and Wes presided over her funeral.**

**"It was almost as if she said, 'I had one last thing to take care of and now I'm done,'" Wes recalled.**

# Nurse Volunteers Bring an Extra Dose of TLC to Hospice Patients

Hospice volunteers come from a variety of backgrounds, but they all provide compassion and companionship, something that is second nature to life-long nurses.



## Terry Granger

Terry Granger has been a registered nurse for 30 years, working at Frederick Health Hospital as a bedside nurse before transitioning to case management. During her career, she has witnessed the impact of hospice care. "These professionals offer care and compassion that is immeasurable and priceless to the patient as well as their loved ones during an intensely emotional time," she said.

Terry has volunteered with Hospice since 2018, offering a compassionate presence to dying patients and their families. **"I've done that throughout my nursing career, so I feel like I know what to say, although a lot of it involves just listening,"** she said.

And last summer, Terry saw hospice from a different perspective when her mother-in-law received hospice care. "I witnessed how they tend to the physical, mental and spiritual needs of the patient while also providing invaluable support to all involved in the patient's care." The experience, although deeply personal, was affirmation for Terry of why she volunteers. "It's truly an honor to be able to volunteer with Hospice and 'give back a little,'" she said.

## Sylvia Anderson

As an Air Force nurse, Sylvia Anderson spent her 30-year career tending to U.S. military personnel in places as remote as Turkey, Saudi Arabia and Somalia, as well as at destinations much closer to home, including the Veterans Administration Hospital in Martinsburg, WV.

Shortly before she retired in 2007, Sylvia adopted a long-haired chihuahua she named Oreo. For years, Sylvia and Oreo, and later Ginger, made volunteer visits to Frederick Health Hospice patients and their families in their homes, at the hospital or at the Kline Hospice House.

"With my background in nursing, I'm comfortable working with hospice patients," Sylvia said. "I know how to react and I understand what they are going through."

## A “Life Raft” for Grieving Families



When Susan and Dan Tipsord’s three-year-old daughter, Christine, passed away at Kline Hospice House from a brain tumor in 2002, they relied upon the grief support provided from Johns Hopkins University Hospital, where Christine received much of her care.

Those services helped Susan, Dan and their surviving daughter, Allison, through their grief journey. The program included separate counseling for children and parents, held during the same timeframe, and included dinner—one less thing the busy family had to worry about.

The Tipsords realized that other families should have access to the same kind of grief support, but without having to travel to Baltimore. “We wanted to bring something similar to Frederick County,” Susan recalled. In 2022, the Tipsords partnered with Frederick Health Hospice to create a program, offered at no charge, for local families who have lost a child. “We have come through our grief to the other side because of the support we got,” Susan said. “We are so blessed that Frederick Health Hospice can now help us touch others in need.”

**Since its inception, Project Christine has helped six grieving families, with one parent writing that it has been a “life raft” for her family.**

Families meet once a week, with the children and parents gathering separately. They share a meal and then work through their grief in conversation, activities and mutual support. Monthly socials at Fox Haven Farm and Retreat Center in Jefferson provide opportunities for the families to come together in nature for relaxed fun and support. “One of the children said that when she comes to this group, she doesn’t have to explain herself since everyone has experienced the same kind of loss she has,” said Jan Hummer, Hospice Child and Family Bereavement Coordinator. “It really has become another kind of family for these survivors.”

## Shared Situations Help Bring Healing to Camp Jamie Participants

The loss of a loved one can be a lonely and alienating experience for people of any age, but for children and adolescents who tend to prioritize peer interactions, the isolation of grief can be especially painful. Through programs like Camp Jamie, bereaved youth discover that they're not alone, and find peers that they can lean on as they grieve together. For many kids, this makes all the difference and can be a turning point in their healing journey.

**“Being with other people who are the same age as me, who went through similar experiences and were feeling the same way that I was really helped,”** said Kenzie, who attended Camp Jamie's Teen Grief Retreat after the death of her father.

Despite Kenzie's initial reluctance to attend, when her mom arrived to pick Kenzie up from camp, she heard lots of chatter and laughter among the teens. “There was a real shared energy between them,” she said.

Kenzie's younger sister attended the overnight Camp Jamie, for students in grades 1-8. She says the major focus was on having fun. “Yes, there is a little bit of emotion, but there's nothing to be scared of and you will make a lot of great friends. I know I have,” she said.



Through expressive and experiential activities, our facilitators help explore grief issues in a safe and supportive setting. All activities provide opportunities for youth to express themselves and develop bonds with others.

## Stitched with Care and Gratitude

Veterans receiving care from Hospice are enjoying an extra gift of warmth and kindness, courtesy of the Clustered Spires Quilt Guild.

Every year, the Guild's 50 or so members choose community projects to support with handmade quilts. "We always do a children's project, but one of our members knew that Hospice has a veterans program and suggested we make that our second project," recalled Kay Rice, the 2022 chair of the Guild's community service committee.

As a retired pastor, Kay has seen firsthand the care and support that Hospice provides to patients and their families. "Hospice is close to my heart," she said. And because several of the Guild's members have family who also served in the military, it became a project that spoke to the entire group.

Over the course of the year, the Guild created 38 quilts (with some members creating more than one) and presented them to Hospice in November. The quilts, which were carefully designed to avoid colors that might trigger PTSD in some veterans, were finished with a custom-made label featuring the American flag and the word "Veteran." "We wanted them to know the quilts were made especially for them because they were veterans," Kay said.



**Hospice Veteran Liaison Bob Lebron had the honor of presenting some of the veterans with their quilts. "The expressions of surprise and awe are attributed to your group," he wrote to the Guild members. "The smiles I wish could be bottled and sent to all of you."**








