FORTY YEARS OF CARE, COMFORT AND HOPE

Since March of 1980, Hospice of Frederick County, now called Frederick Health Hospice, has been promoting quality of life by providing compassionate medical, emotional, spiritual and bereavement support to individuals and their loved ones facing a life-limiting illness. As we approach our 40th anniversary, we are pleased to share a brief review of the milestones that have shaped our history.

“When we reached out to Hospice, we knew they would help us take care of my late husband. What we didn’t know—and could never have imagined—was how deeply they would care, or how much a part of our family they would become. Hospice of Frederick County began with a conversation initiated in 1979 by a local organization called Church Women United. The group invited clergy, lay people, and medical professionals to discuss how care was being provided to those facing life-limiting illness here in Frederick. They asked questions like “Shouldn’t care plans include not just the patient but the entire family unit?” and “Shouldn’t pain management include addressing emotional and spiritual suffering along with physical discomfort?”

The answers the group arrived at to these questions changed everything about the way people in Frederick living with life-limiting illness were cared for. “The key word here is **living**,” says Laurel Cucchi, a participant in those early discussions who went on to serve the organization as its Executive Director for more than 30 years. “The most progressive thing Hospice did at the beginning and continues to do to this day was to take the focus off dying and put it on **living**.”

In March of 1980, Frederick County’s first hospice program incorporated under the name “Hospice of Frederick County.” “We were all volunteers back then,” says retired oncologist Dr. P. Gregory Rausch, “doing what we thought was needed. We were involved in establishing laws for hospice programs and helped to set up the Hospice Network of Maryland.”

The concept of relieving “total pain” was put to the test during the 1980s when the AIDs epidemic arrived at Hospice’s door. “At that time, no one really knew what AIDs was, how to treat it, or how to contain it,” says Cucchi. “For a few years, we were the only ones in Frederick taking care of patients with AIDs. We had a regional reputation for our care and response to the epidemic.”

After Dr. Dana Cable, a Hospice volunteer and practicing psychologist, shared his experience at a camp for children who were grieving in Walla Walla, Washington with Cucchi, Hospice of Frederick County decided to create Camp Jamie. The founding of this special camp in 1991 for kids who had lost a loved one took the concept of bereavement care to a new level. Camp Jamie pairs a child who is grieving with a specially trained “big buddy,” who has often experienced a similar loss. Early attendees of the Camp are now returning as the next generation of big buddies, helping kids process loss just as they were once supported.

In 1997, Hospice of Frederick County and Frederick Regional Health System’s hospice program joined forces, forging a new era in hospice care in our community. As an affiliate of Frederick Regional Health System, and with continued community support, Hospice has grown exponentially.

In 2002, the doors opened to the Kline Hospice House, a six-bedroom care facility near Mount Airy that has become a nationwide model for residential hospice care. Over the past decade, Hospice care in Frederick has grown to include music therapy, a support program for veterans, and an expanded bereavement program. Just last year, Hospice of Frederick County simplified its name to Frederick Health Hospice.

“The care, comfort, and hope that our staff and volunteers have been providing to those facing life-limiting illness has been the backbone of what Hospice does for the last 40 years,” says Frederick Health Hospice Executive Director Carlos Graveran, “And that will never change.”

Director's Corner

Once again this year, legislation comes before the Maryland General Assembly that would make it legal for doctors to prescribe a lethal dose of medication to terminally ill patients who want to end their lives. The bill, modeled after legislation already enacted into law in Oregon, has been narrowly defeated four times in as many years, but advocates argue that patients with life-limiting illnesses should have a greater say in how and when to end their lives.

At its core, this legislation is driven by the desire for patients to have more control and agency over the decisions that affect their lives. The issue is a byproduct of the enormous advances in the science of medicine that can sometimes keep a patient "alive" indefinitely, and the failure of our healthcare providers to recognize the difference between what can be done and what should be done. It is a cry for mercy from those who fear prolonged pain and suffering and the loss of dignity.

What is most frustrating to me about this debate is the fact that a care pathway already exists that reduces pain and suffering, allows patients to retain their dignity, and aligns medical care with their stated wishes; it's called hospice. For the past forty years, our hospice and countless others across the country have labored to put control back into the hands of the patient. Yet despite our collective efforts, far too few patients avail themselves of hospice services at end-of-life, and when they do, it is often far too late to make a real difference. At times, it's fear and misunderstanding that keep them away; more often it's driven by unrealistic expectations or the reluctance of those in whom they place their trust to share the unvarnished truth of their prognosis.

Having played an active role in my own father's end-of-life journey, I can empathize with the emotions on both sides of this debate. My goal here is not to share my opinion, but rather my fear that this debate might further confuse and drive patients away from hospice services. Hospice is already often mistaken as a place where you go to die. That statement could not be further from the truth. Hospice is not a place, it's a philosophy of care that is centered upon a patient's wishes and focused on living life right up until the end. It's an acknowledgement of our humanity and mortality, and predicated on the recognition that quality of life is far more precious than its measure in days.

When a Loved One Dies from Overdose: Supporting our First Responders

Our work with those who are grieving has taught us that every death sets in motion a unique type of grief. This is particularly true for people whose loved one dies following an overdose.

In partnership with the Frederick County Health Department, Frederick Health Hospice has created a position to support first responders who must notify a family that a loved one has died due to overdose. Thanks to a grant from the state of Maryland, these first responders will now be accompanied by a bereavement specialist who will help guide the way the family is told about their loved one's death, and provide compassion, support, and resources as they begin to grieve.

How can Hospice support Heart Disease?

Heart disease is the leading cause of death in adults in the United States. CHF is a type of heart disease that develops when the heart no longer pumps blood effectively or can no longer relax after it pumps blood. This results in a backup of fluid throughout the body, most noticeably in the lower legs or in the lungs. When it occurs in the legs, this backup of fluid, called edema, can cause pain, interfere with mobility, and lead to the development of wounds. In the lungs, edema causes breathlessness and poor endurance.

Physicians can prescribe medications to help the heart function better, and these medications can offer years of relief. However, as CHF progresses, even the most effective medications can't restore the function of the heart, and patients become more and more symptomatic.

If you or a loved one is in the late stages of Congestive Heart Failure, talk to your doctor about how Hospice might be able to help.

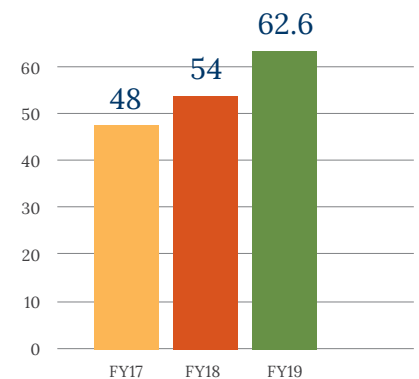

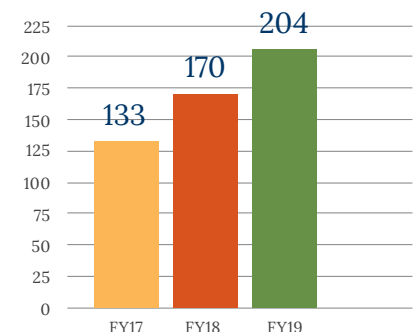

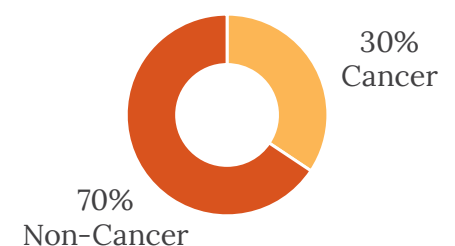
Average Length of Stay (in days)

Then you came to visit. And to be honest, at the beginning, Dad didn't really seem to know what was going on. He looked so small and confused, scrunched down in his big reclining chair. But as you got further into your presentation, I noticed that Dad was sitting up a little taller. I saw a glimmer of the twinkle that's been in his eye for 93 years but had recently gone out.

You displayed a remarkable demeanor with my Dad. You showed him so much respect. YOU SPOKE LOUD enough for him to hear your words. And when you saluted him, I could see, without a shadow of a doubt, Dad's pride for that long ago time of his life when he served so bravely as a Navy pilot. After you left, he even felt strong enough to go outside with his sons and enjoy one last cigar. It was a day I'll always remember.

Dad passed away in his sleep Monday morning, still wearing the pins you gave him, in the same chair where you made him feel so important. Thank you for making a big deal out of the man who made us so proud all our lives. Your visit meant so much. If you ever had a doubt about what you're doing, please know that I firmly believe that God put you in that position, where your gifts can bring cheer to those who need it most.

For Grieving Kids, Camp Jamie is Life-Changing

After his mother's unexpected death in January of 2019, Tyler Gorman changed. "He was happy and full of life," says his father, Will, "but he became hollow and emotionless." Changes in behavior and personality are common among grieving children, but the changes that Will observed in his son were alarming to him. "I didn't know what to do," he says.

When Will learned about Camp Jamie, he knew he wanted Tyler to attend. While both Will and Tyler were nervous, and didn't know quite what to expect, they also knew that something needed to change. Will signed Tyler up to attend the overnight camp in May.

Will's anxiety quickly disappeared when he came to pick up Tyler from camp. "The smile on his face, the fact that he was laughing with other kids... I could see that Tyler was coming back to where he used to be," he says.

The Gormans' involvement with Camp Jamie goes far beyond Tyler's attendance at the overnight camp. Will and Tyler both attended the Camp Jamie Reunion at Terrace Lanes Bowling Alley in August, and Tyler has stayed in touch with his friends from Camp and his "Big Buddy."

Tyler and Will also attended Camp Jamie Day Camp in September. At the day camp, father and son did several activities together that Will says "really helped us communicate better about feelings and grief, and taught us some

other skills that we've been able to use at home. It was a game-changer."

For Will Gorman, part of grieving and honoring his wife's memory is making sure that other families in our community grieving the loss of a loved one by suicide and other sudden causes of death related to mental health have the same opportunity as his son had to benefit from Camp Jamie. Now, nearing the one-year anniversary of his wife's death, Will is looking for a way to give back to the program through what he hopes will be an annual fundraising event called "Jammin' 4 Jamie's Kids", a day of food, fun, and music to benefit Camp Jamie.

"Camp Jamie was life-changing for Tyler, for me, and for our family. I am forever grateful."

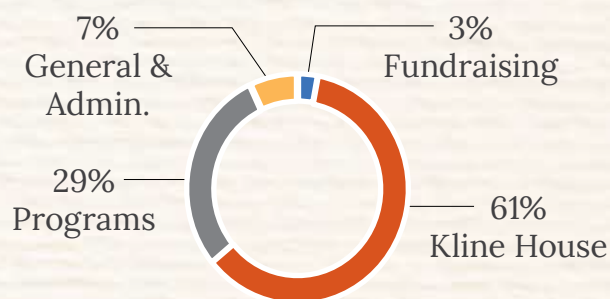

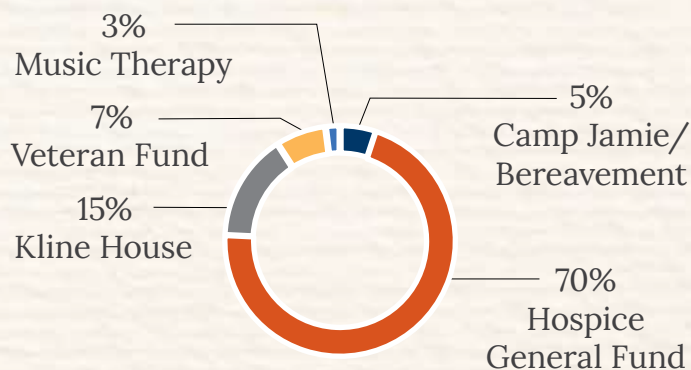

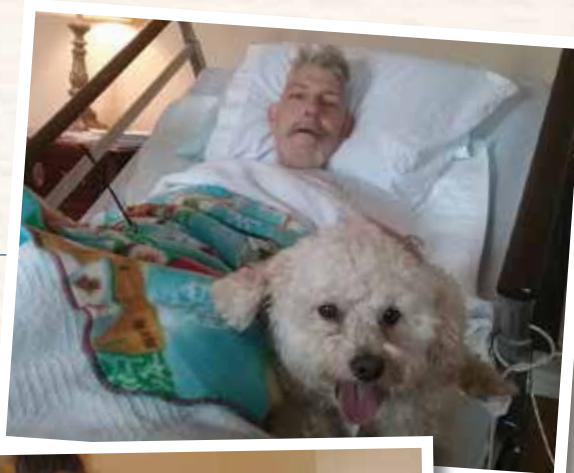
